- He said, 'Then, father, I beg you to send him to my father's house— 28 for I have five brothers—that he may warn them, so that they will not also come into this place of torment.'
- Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the prophets; they should listen to them.'

3. Why did King Ahab want Naboth's vineyard and how did he get it? (L12 P62) Naboth the Jezreelite had a vineyard in Jezreel, beside the palace of King Ahab of Samaria. King Ahab wanted the vineyard to make his vegetable garden, and because it was near to his house.

King Ahab was depressed and did not eat. His wife, Jezebel, after learning the reason for his being upset, asked mockingly, "Are you not the king?" She then said that she would obtain the vineyard for him. To do so, she sent a letter, under Ahab's name, to the elders and nobles of Naboth's city, instructing them to set Naboth up by proclaiming a feast, seating him in a prominent place and bringing two witnesses, referred to as "scoundrels" by Jezebel, forth to (falsely) accuse Naboth of cursing God and the king. After that, they would take him outside the city and stone him to death. As per Jezebel's plan, the two scoundrels came in and sat

opposite him; and the scoundrels brought a charge against Naboth, in the presence of the people, saying, "Naboth cursed God and the king." So, they took him outside the city, and stoned him to death.

# 3. Name <u>any five symbols</u> associated with the Mar Thoma Order of Worship. Briefly describe each symbol.

**<u>Tableetha</u>**: It is a small rectangular wooden tablet or board placed upon the thronos. Tableetha can be used as a portable altar. It is kept as a reminder for purity.

**Thronos**: The consecrated table that serves as the altar in the Madbaha is called 'Thronos'. The Thronos is made of stone and is a symbol of divine presence. This is the table, which is used for the consecration of the elements in the Holy Qurbana.

<u>Madbaha</u>: The word Madbaha is an Aramaic word meaning an altar to celebrate the Qurbana. Madbaha reminds us of the divine presence of God.

**Incense**: an offering. The smoke from the incense is a symbol of the divine presence. The cloud and incense stand for the invisible presence of the Lord.

<u>Censer</u>: Three chains on censer stand for the Holy Trinity. The bells attached to the chains symbolizes the teachings of the twelve Apostles.

<u>**Cross</u>**: symbolizes eternal life granted to humanity through Christ's sacrificial act. It symbolizes light, peace, and the new life received through Christ.</u>

**Kappa**: vestment that the priest wears during Holy Qurbana and other sacraments. They are made "for glory and beauty".

Light: calls us to shine light the light in a world of darkness

- a. Jeremiah was a prophet who ministered during the reign of a good king, King Josiah. His ministry lasted some 40 years. Jeremiah was timid due to young age and inexperience, but he was:

- b. God gives him three promises to introduce a prophetic vision to Jeremiah.

1. The almond tree. The budding of the almond tree announced the coming of spring. Jeremiah would do ministry under some very difficult circum- stances. It would not always look as though God is at work. Jeremiah needed to be reassured that God is at work to fulfill His word.

2. The boiling pot. The pot was coming out of the north (Babylon was a nation in what is now Iraq). God is saying to Jeremiah that He is going to judge and discipline His people for their sin. God is not going to continue to look the other way. The main sin that God accuses the people of is idolatry. They have forsaken Him and turned to idols that their hands made. God has unbelievable patience and longsuffering, but a day of judgment comes. God is Holy. He can't allow disobedience to go on indefinitely.

3. The city, a pillar and a wall. God doesn't leave Jeremiah to do this ministry alone. 9

God strengthens Jeremiah, so that he can be faithful. God as- sures him again of his protection and to stand against abuse and persecution.

One afternoon Cornelius had a vision in which he clearly saw an angel of God coming in and saying to him, "Cornelius." He stared at him in terror and said, "What is it, Lord?" He answered, "Your prayers and your alms have ascended as a memorial before God. Now send men to Joppa for a certain Simon who is called Peter; he is lodging with Simon, a tanner, whose house is by the seaside."

Peter went up on the roof to pray, he fell into a trance. He saw the heaven opened and something like a large sheet coming down, being lowered to the ground by its four corners. In it were all kinds of four-footed creatures and reptiles and birds of the air. Then he heard a voice saying, "Get up, Peter; kill and eat." But Peter said, "By no means, Lord; for I have never eaten anything that is profane or unclean." The voice said to him again, a second time, "What God has made clean, you must not call profane." This happened three times, and the thing was suddenly taken up to heaven.

Peter met the three men sent by Cornelius, he invited them in and gave them lodging. The next day he got up and went with them, and some of the believers from Joppa accompanied him to Caesarea.

On Peter's arrival Cornelius met him, and falling at his feet, worshiped him. But Peter made him get up, saying, "Stand up; I am only a mortal." And as he talked with him, he went in and found that many had assembled; and he said to them, "You yourselves know that it is unlawful for a Jew to associate with or to visit a Gentile; but God has shown me that I should not call anyone profane or unclean. Then Peter began to speak to them: "I truly understand that God shows no partiality, but in every nation, anyone who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him. While Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who heard the word.
